

**Position Title:** Lead Recovery Coach (LSW) – GBHI Grant



**Job Summary:**

The Lead Recovery Coach (LSW) will oversee and provide recovery coaching and outreach services under the Grant to Benefit Homeless Individuals (GBHI). This position requires the ability to model best practices in recovery coaching, supervise Mobile Recovery Coaches, and ensure program fidelity to the recovery coaching model. The Lead Recovery Coach will play a vital role in supporting individuals experiencing homelessness and substance use disorder (SUD), connecting them to necessary services and resources.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Provide direct recovery coaching services to individuals, offering guidance, support, and linkage to treatment and social services.
- Lead and mentor Mobile Recovery Coaches by demonstrating effective coaching strategies, ensuring consistency in service delivery, and adherence to recovery principles.
- Conduct regular assessments of clients to create personalized recovery plans and maintain ongoing communication to track progress.
- Collaborate with social service agencies, shelters, medical providers, and substance use treatment facilities to coordinate care and enhance services.
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date case records and documentation of services provided.
- Assist with outreach efforts, focusing on underserved populations, particularly in Atlantic County, NJ.
- Support the development of program policies and procedures, ensuring alignment with GBHI grant goals.
- Participate in regular staff meetings, trainings, and professional development activities.

**Qualifications:**

- Licensed Social Worker (LSW) in New Jersey.
- Minimum of 3 years of experience working with individuals affected by homelessness, substance use disorder, or co-occurring disorders.
- Strong knowledge of the recovery coaching model, harm reduction, and trauma-informed care.
- Experience with Atlantic County’s social services and recovery-related resources.
- Excellent communication and organizational skills, with the ability to work independently and collaboratively.
- Demonstrated commitment to cultural awareness and sensitivity in working with diverse populations.

**Supervision:**

The Lead Recovery Coach will report directly to the Project Director and supervise Mobile Recovery Coaches under the GBHI grant.
